

Mandeville High School Junior Varsity Assistant Coach Vacancy Announcement

The Mandeville High School Lacrosse program has an established commitment to excellence that will continue to help it grow and be successful. The program is a club program that plays in the Louisiana High School Lacrosse League. It has a Booster Club Board that supports it in fundraising, organization and logistics.

The Junior Varsity program is made up of mostly 9-11th grade athletes and first time lacrosse players. The programs vision, mission and core values are as follows:

JV Vision: We are prepared both in individual skills and lacrosse IQ to be “next man up” at the varsity level.

JV Mission: We do everything with a purpose, in life and in lacrosse.

JV Core Values:

Fun: Have fun, play hard, be competitive.

Learning: Learn something even when you don’t think you have something to learn.

Team: Be a good teammate in all things including:

Actions (Good passing, backup, hustle, and work)

Words (Positive reinforcement, constructive feedback, and leadership)

Spirit (Respect, Loyalty, bonding, protection, and family)

A Junior Varsity Assistant Coach will emphasize the importance of a positive team culture, demonstrate a winning attitude, model exceptional sportsmanship and will be a skilled teacher of fundamentals, strategy and character. He/she will support, teach and represent the junior varsity program’s Vision, Mission, and Core Values.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Encourage, train, and coach the participants of the boys lacrosse program (Grades 9-11);
- Collaborate with the other lacrosse coaches as needed;
- Organize practice sessions;

- Represent Mandeville High School and the boys lacrosse program in a professional manner and within the bounds of good sportsmanship.

EXPECTED TIME COMMITMENT: The athletes are held to a high attendance standard that the coaches will set by example.

- The seasons is broken up into two parts Fall and Spring (Regular)
 - Fall will have a time requirement of 2 hours 2 days a week for practices/clinics
 - Spring will have a time requirement of:
 - 2 hours 5 weekdays (non game days) a week for practice and film.
 - 1 hour before game time and 30 minutes after game time plus game time on away game days
 - 2 hours before game time and 1 hour after game time plus game time on home games. This includes varsity game time.
- The program as a whole has numerous team building and fundraising activities that coaches are expected to attend.

- Possess and maintain a coaching philosophy that is in accordance with the vision, mission and values of Mandeville High School Junior Varsity Lacrosse program and Mandeville High School.;
- A strong commitment to the student-athlete concept;

- Effective leadership, coaching and recruiting skills;
- Good communication skills with players, parents, and the athletic department;
